

Policy Statement Health and Safety

- 1.1 It is the policy of Enquin Environmental Ltd to carry out its operations so that the health, safety and welfare of its employees, contractors and others not in our employment are not adversely affected by the company operations.
- 1.2 Enquin Environmental Ltd will work at all times in compliance with the requirements of the Health and Safety at Work etc Act 1974.
- 1.3 This will include all other Acts and Regulations, Approved Codes of Practice and Health and Safety Executive Guidance Notes applicable to the company operations. The company will also need to comply with the health and safety requirements of clients and contractors, as directed, while upon their premises and/or acting on their behalf.

Employees are at all times to work safely and to be aware that by their actions or omissions that they do not create danger to themselves or others.
- 1.5 Health and Safety Advisors acting on the company's behalf are to report to the Health and Safety Director, any unsafe practices etc. as soon as possible and confirm their findings of any inspections or audits they perform in writing.
- 1.6 Health and Safety training of all employees is provided to enable our operations to be performed safely, without damage to health, equipment and/or property and to further comply with current legislations.
